XI. Appropriate Eye Contact -

- Eyes leaving audience intentionally for dramatic effect will not be penalized/counted (Twice is acceptable, after that, each will be tallied)
- For every second the speaker's eyes leave the audience (Ex. speaker reading slides) = 1 tally mark
- Speaker is allowed to glance at slide to ensure they're on the correct slide (1 second) with no penalty, after that, each will be tallied)
- If speaker points something out specifically in the slide = no penalty
